







Full Member 1 players, for instance, choose to pay a small competition fee and enjoy unlimited free social golf. This membership is ideal for the regular competition golfer.

Full Member 2:

Full Member 2 players enjoy unlimited free social golf but pay a larger competition fee.

Full Member 3 & Full Member 4:

Social Golfing Member:

18 years and over. Ineligible for competitions, social golf green fee applicable. No AGU handicap. Student:

18 to 25 years. Full Time Student with Student ID Card. Pays same green fee and competition fee as Full Member 3 members.

Junior (AGU):

Under 18 years with an AGU handicap. Low green fee and competition fee.

Junior (Non AGU):

Under 18 years without an AGU handicap. Ineligible for competitions. Free social golf.





Juniors

Bargara Golf Club is proud of the part it is playing in introducing the next generation of players to the game of golf. The club offers girls and boys of all ages the chance to experience golf in a fun, safe, social environment.

The mission of Bargara Junior Golf Club is to enhance the enjoyment, knowledge, and appreciation of the game of golf for every junior involved. This is accomplished with the help of parents, volunteers and the Club Professional who are on hand to help every junior with his or her individual needs.

Coaching consists of teaching all the necessary basics including grip, stance, ball position, posture and alignment and covers both the short game and long game, so that juniors are supplied with the required skills to take to the golf course. Equipment can be provided.

Bargara Junior Golf promotes a spirit of friendly competition and relies on total honesty and courtesy. Overall, golf is an activity in which young players develop positive values to take into adulthood while learning a skill for life.

Bargara is a supporter of MyGolf, Australia's national junior introductory program to develop and promote participation in golf.

The MyGolf program is aimed at a fun, accessible and satisfying introduction to the game by promoting skills development in an accredited coaching environment while promoting the social and fun aspects of the

The MyGolf program at Bargara is five sessions usually held on successive Saturday mornings. On the last Saturday the children are taken out onto the course to play an Ambrose event and familiarise them more with the rules, safety and etiquette of golf play

and give them a taste of what it would be like to continue with their new golf skills at the club.

Group sizes are limited to a maximum of eight children for each five-week program to give each child quality time with Golf Pro Phil Curd in an optimum environment to nurture their introduction to the skills of golf.

Junior competitions are held on Sunday mornings. Those juniors with official golf handicaps play 18 holes, others play 13 or nine holes from the normal tees and the more inexperienced youngsters enjoy either nine, six or three holes from a modified hole set-up from 150 metres.

New juniors are appraised and placed in divisions they feel comfortable in. The season ends with a Junior Breakup Breakfast at The Basin and a trophy presentation.

Bargara has some very talented junior players, some of whom represent the club in pennant competition. They are also encouraged to play in competitions at other clubs locally and, should they wish, elsewhere across

The club has always been a champion of junior golf, hosting the successful Bargara Junior Classic for many years and, in recent years, the Queensland State Junior championships.

Skin cancer treatment at GenesisCare

Designing Better Care for Patients with Non-Melanoma Skin Cancer

Shorter treatment times and less side effects.¹

Australia has one of the highest rates of skin cancer in the world, and approximately two in three Australians will be diagnosed with skin cancer before age 70.2 People who have spent time working outdoors can receive up to 10 times more sun exposure than indoor workers ³ Surgery is standard treatment, but it can sometimes be cosmetically challenging, particularly if the lesion is on the face, or areas of the body where skin can be thin such as the lower leg. Multiple non-melanoma skin cancers that spread across a wider area of skin can also be difficult to remove surgically, and topical treatments or 'freezing' of the cancers are not always a suitable alternative.

Advances in Radiation Therapy

Radiation therapy has been used to treat non-melanoma skin cancers for many years, and recent advances in technology have revolutionised its use. The latest techniques now enable treatment to be delivered with more precision and accuracy than ever before.

"Radiation therapy has seen some fantastic advances in the last few decades, improving capacity to treat non-melanoma skin cancers," explains Dermatologist Dr Robert Sinclair. "Most skin cancers can now be treated with great outcomes, both physically and cosmetically. This provides a real alternative for our patients, especially the elderly, those with medical conditions, or patients taking blood thinners who are less suitable for surgery."

The team at GenesisCare have seen a significant change in the way skin treatments can now be delivered and the positive impact this can have on patients and their families.

"Previously, it could be tricky to shape radiation beams around curved surfaces and deliver an even dose just to the skin. Using the latest treatment technology, we can now precisely shape the radiation to the treatment area whilst sparing normal surrounding tissue. This means that we can effectively and more accurately treat skin cancers on and around the face, or multiple lesions spreading across the forearm, leg or scalp," explained radiation oncologist, Dr Bradley Wong.

A Patient Story

Gai has been visiting her skin specialist for many years and has had various lesions treated locally. When one lesion started deteriorating at a faster rate, Gai rushed back from a holiday to see her specialist. After conversations about potential surgery, her consultant referred her to GenesisCare to discuss radiation therapy, feeling surgery may not be the best option due to the wide-field cancerisation and delicate skin area on Gai's leg.

Gai's long history of basal and squamous cell carcinomas (keratinocyte cancers) and the placement on her leg of her current lesion, made her a good candidate for radiation treatment.

Gai received daily treatments over a 7-week period, which included a 2-week break in the middle to assist with some swelling and discomfort – common side effects of radiation treatment, especially in the legs. However, with the advances in radiation therapy in the last 5 years, side-effects are much less severe as the therapy is now only treating the skin, not the underlying layers.

Six-months post-treatment, Gai was back doing all the things she loves – including her tennis and running around with her new great-grandchild.

GenesisCare doctors use the latest techniques to treat non-melanoma skin cancer without the use of surgery or general anaesthetic.
